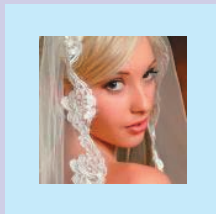

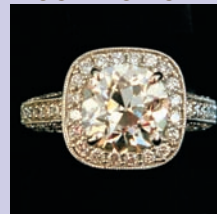

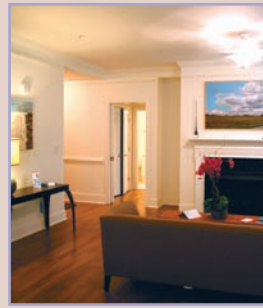
### AMERICAN BOARD OF ANESTHESIOLOGY RELOCATING TO NORTH HILLS
